CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN

As a valuable member service, the Chamber certifies documents required in the sale of goods and services to foreign countries. This certification is officially recognized by overseas customs officials, foreign governments and international businesses. Many times a Certificate of Origin is required for products exported outside of the United States. By filling out a Certificate of Origin, a shipper is certifying that the covered goods meet the rules of origin. The Juniata River Valley Chamber will place a seal and a signature on all completed certificates. This is a **FREE** service for our members. **Non-members are \$20/per certificate**. Please call ahead to ensure a staff member will be available when needed to avoid delays (717)248-6713.


DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From State College, PA – From US-322 E, take the East Charles Street Exit. Go straight through first traffic light. Second traffic light turn right onto Main Street. Go straight through next traffic light and enter Market Street roundabout. Get into left lane and Historic Courthouse is right on the corner.

From Harrisburg, PA – From US-322W, take Lewistown Ramp after the Narrows. Veer Right onto South Main Street. Go straight through two traffic lights. Enter Market Street roundabout. Historic Courthouse is right on the corner.

From Huntingdon, PA – From US-22S, past Sheetz, get into left lane. At traffic light, veer left onto Market Street. Stay in left lane, go straight through traffic light. Enter Market Street roundabout. Historic Courthouse is right on the corner.

From Selinsgrove, PA - From US-522. 522 becomes S Walnut St. At traffic light turn left onto Valley Street. Turn slight Right onto East 3rd Street. Get into left lane, at second traffic light turn Left onto North Main Street. Historic Courthouse is right on the corner.
